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## Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH)

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### What is a Medical Home?

A Medical Home means delivering patient treatment which is coordinated through the primary care provider to ensure receipt of the necessary care when and where needed, in a manner easy to understand.

The objective is to have a centralized setting that aids partnerships between individual patients, their primary care provider, and when appropriate, the patient's family. Care is facilitated by registries, information technology, health information exchanges and other means to ensure patients get indicated care when and where they need and want.

A Medical Home will ask you to choose a provider to keep you healthy. Care will be focused on the whole being; not just one part or problem. You can decide to have your family included in decisions regarding your health care.

As a Patient Centered Medical Home, we consider it our responsibility to meet the needs of our patients using many different resources, including walk in and same day appointments. Your health care needs can be met by any of our providers and the management of your care will be coordinated through referrals with other providers as needed.
